Proclamation

By J<sup>r</sup> Gouernors & Councill of Mary Land.

Whereas I am given to understand of J<sup>r</sup> counsels being actually on foot, intending (if possibly they may  
 misde us: And considering J<sup>r</sup> danger of J<sup>r</sup> part times, & how troublesome & inconvenient it may prove  
 divers J<sup>r</sup> of this pro: & prejudicial to J<sup>r</sup> whole, to hold a Court in J<sup>r</sup> beginning of June next  
 partly all causes being to be tryed by a Jury: w<sup>ch</sup> will much weaken those parts from whence they come  
 than being nec<sup>y</sup> business of J<sup>r</sup> consequence, or too urgent, at this time, in J<sup>r</sup> fine: to be heard & determined  
 but may suffer delay. And being desirous to provide in J<sup>r</sup> best manner I may for J<sup>r</sup> good & safety of J<sup>r</sup> pro  
 These are to give notice, to all J<sup>r</sup> of J<sup>r</sup> County, & to all others whom it may concerne, That  
 have advised all causes, to be tryed this next Court, in J<sup>r</sup> beginning of June, untill October next. For  
 forcing all writs, warrants, or other processes returnable, this next Court as afore<sup>s</sup> untill October  
 all J<sup>r</sup> & others, warrant upon summons, bound to attend this Court, and to take notice hereof &  
 attendance at J<sup>r</sup> Court to be held in J<sup>r</sup> beginning of Octob<sup>r</sup> as afore<sup>s</sup>. Given at J<sup>r</sup> Mary this 22<sup>d</sup>
