Cap<sup>t</sup>. Edw: Hill demanded five of Bond & Cunnell of Arrears of what considered  
 was contracted unto him by Gen: Robert Doy for his service in office of  
 Govern<sup>r</sup> of this province being of half of his L<sup>ts</sup> Rents for 6 years 1646  
 of half of Customs for 6 same years.

The Accounts of Customs of 6 years claimed unto by Cap<sup>t</sup>. Edw: Hill, not  
 being at present time to be had. It was ordered, that of half of 6 years customs  
 as far as it hath not already bene received by Cap<sup>t</sup>. Hill, shall be paid unto  
 him, by the L<sup>ts</sup> Doy's Attorney, out of the first profits, which shall be receivable to  
 his L<sup>ts</sup>. And time is allotted to Cap<sup>t</sup>. Hill, to bring proof what of 6 Customs  
 amounted to: until Octob<sup>r</sup> Court. And likewise of his L<sup>ts</sup> Receiver shall certify  
 to pay unto Cap<sup>t</sup>. Edw: Hill, or his assignes, of one half of his L<sup>ts</sup> Rents due at  
 Christmas next, in lieu of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Rents of 6 years 1646. which were otherwise  
 paid of to his L<sup>ts</sup> use.

13 June

Giles Brent Esq<sup>r</sup> complayned unto Cuthbert Henrich Gent, for unjust molestation  
 for 6 he of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Cuth: Henrich hath arrested upon him for 2500 of Tob: in  
 a foreign Court, under pretence of wages due from him to 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Giles Brent  
 unto James Cuthbert's Admirals, or Exequutors. which demand he of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Brent  
 hath already bene impleaded for in this Province Court: And is ready to pay  
 the award of 6 Court, which will not be received. Wherefore he prays of the  
 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Cuth: Henrich may be ordered to receive his due in 6 L<sup>ts</sup> demand accord-  
 ing to 6 judgment of this Court, & to give him a release from 6 L<sup>ts</sup> vexation  
 & layme.

warrant to 6 Sheriff to keep 6 Body of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Cuth: Hen: in safe custody, until  
 he shall put on security of 3000. Tob: to stand to 6 award of this Court.

I doe hereby oblig<sup>e</sup> my selfe, my heires & assignes under forfeiture of 3000  
 to 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Doy, to stand to 6 award of 6 Province Court of Maryland, in an  
 now depending therein, betweene Giles Brent Esq<sup>r</sup> & my selfe, concerning a demand  
 of 2500 Tob: which I have of him, as wages due from him to 6 Exequutors or  
 heires of James Cuthbert deceased. Witness my hand. Cuth: Henrich.

14 June

Edward Packer sayth upon his oath y<sup>t</sup> sometime in May or June 1644, Symon  
 antson then Sheriff of 6 County of Kent, by warrant from Cap<sup>t</sup>. Giles Brent, then Gov<sup>r</sup> of  
 Pro: of Maryland, did seise certaine neatte cattle, to 6 number of 27 then on 6  
 of M<sup>r</sup>. Will<sup>m</sup>. Cox, being of whole number then acknowledged apperteyning to  
 Claybornes stock, for 6 use of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Baltimore. And further he sayth, that he  
 commiss<sup>r</sup> from 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Gov<sup>r</sup> of 6 reyse of 6 Commiss<sup>r</sup> for his L<sup>ts</sup> estate, to receive all  
 cattle soe seised as aforesaid, into his poss<sup>n</sup>. for 6 use of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Baltimore. And further  
 sayth, that upon 6 receive of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> cattle, 13 of them, were immediately brought away  
 this day from 6 house of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> M<sup>r</sup>. Cox to Kent Row, & 6 of other 9 Cattle  
 of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Will<sup>m</sup>. Cox) were left by order from 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Gov<sup>r</sup> in 6 poss<sup>n</sup>. of 6 L<sup>ts</sup> M<sup>r</sup>. Cox  
 to be carew accomptable for them & their increase to 6 L<sup>ts</sup> Baltimore or his assignes  
 when ever he should be called thereunto. And further he sayth out.
