employed of the forenamed Hen: Brooke. Requeses to Capt Robt Vaughan may
be appointed to give up unto him, upon his oath, & acct of such goods taken
his & debts, as was in his hands: or as he had disposed of, appertaining to

as many of of Bills, & accounts, as should satisfy of Two above named summes,
unto him. w^{ch} were these following Viz, M^r. Cox's clear acct. 375^l Tob: & cash.
J^{es} Bennetts^{clear} debt, by Bill & acct. 439^l Tob: & cash. Hen: Morgans Bill
400^l Tob: & cash. Fran: Lombards Bill 200^l M^r. Giles Brents acct. 28^l
w^{ch} his own acct of 8264 satisfied his demand unto him. The Court further
ordered of of J^{es} Vaughan should deliver in all of rest of of Bills, & accounts
of of foref^d estate to of Attorney; And of of foref^d Attorney should deliver to of
Capt. Vaughan of Specialties, w^{ch} he had given to of Hen: Brooke upon re-
ceipt of those goods from him, from whence of above summes of Tob: & cash
came due.
