In answer to of Mr. J. Henry Potter deposes & sayth

To of 1st That he never heard him of Mr. Hall say, he would give him of Mr. Manners any satisfaction for his corne. But for his junkin vines, which the hogs of of Mr. Edward Hall had spoiled, he would satisfy of Mr. Manners therefor: & this he promised to of boys of his remembrance, sometime in June last.

To of 2^d He sayth nothing.

To of 3^d He sayth, if he did hear of Mr. Hall say, if when of Mr. George was absent, he would give of swine meate.

To of 4th He sayth That he did see of Mr. Hall pull some things from of hog-pen down, if made it fast; sometime when of Mr. George was absent.

To of 5th He sayth, if some of of hogs were in of Corne field of next day: But none in of pen.

July 1st 1648. The Dep^o of Edward Hudson taken before of Governour.

This Dep^o sayth if he heard Henry Clay say, if he thought he had hurt a hog or two of Henry Morgans (he spoke of it to Tho: Munday) & further sayth if Clay att of him: spoke such words, if of Dep^o did believe by them, if of Mr. Clay had killed a hog, & if Clay asked Munday what in his hearing, what he should doe wth of flesh, if he had killed of hog. And Munday answered, if yo^r have killed a hog, yo^r had best tell Morgans of it, if he never knew Clay to bring any hogs flesh to Mundayes, or wth, or if yo^r point how to have any brought thither. Further he deposes not.
