But at  $\bar{f}$  rising up to believ on  $\bar{f}$  Verdict, hee heard one man move any  
further tarryance. & soe himselfe came along, to  $\bar{f}$  delivery of  $\bar{f}$  Verdict. In  
 $\bar{f}$  rest he agrees w<sup>th</sup>  $\bar{f}$  foreman.

Jane  $\bar{f}$  wife of Thomas Warr<sup>e</sup> deposed, sayth,  $\bar{f}$  there was in  $\bar{f}$  roomes, where  
 $\bar{f}$  Jury came in, to returne their Verdict. And  $\bar{f}$  there heard, demanded of the  
Jury, if they were all agreed. &  $\bar{f}$  there heard  $\bar{f}$  foreman say, Yes; And W<sup>m</sup>.  
Styles, being behind  $\bar{f}$  rest, shee heard him, say, Noe. But whether it was to  $\bar{f}$   
question, demanded of  $\bar{f}$  Jury, or not, shee knoweth not.

Whereas Will<sup>m</sup>. Styles, not expressing such a disaffere, as  $\bar{f}$  rest of  $\bar{f}$  Jury, or
