These are to give notice to all y^e persons, to whom it may concerne, by y^e Gov^t (for special
reasons therein moving) to suspend & revoke all power & authority of Command
the Gov^t of Kent from Cap^t Rob^t Vaughan, the Com^{and} of y^e Gov^t of Kent, & doe require & charge
charge all y^e Inhab^{ts} of y^e Gov^t of Kent from their obedience formerly due unto his Com^{and}
until they shall bee thereunto required againe by speciall Com^{and} from y^e Gov^t of
this Province for y^e time being. And y^e Gov^t further hereby require & authorize M^r
Philip Carter, one of y^e Com^{and} of y^e Gov^t County of Kent, to the forth all writs &
processes necessary for y^e administration of Justice in y^e Gov^t County: Binding all Parties
interested near to y^e Provinciale Court, at S^t. Maryes, there to beare trye & determin
and their issues & causes, until further order shall be taken thereon; finding it
necessary for y^e Gov^t to suspend all further power of Judicature upon y^e Gov^t of Kent.

Relying upon yo^r faithfulness & courage y^e Gov^t hereby committ unto yo^r & able unbr^d
officer of High Sheriff^e of y^e County of Kent, the Com^{and} of all y^e Militia of y^e Gov^t
County, requiring yo^r to take charge thereof: And upon any invasion from abroad
or mutiny, insolence, or other breach of Peace at home, or in daungering y^e publick
safety of yo^r County, to encounter & suppress y^e same, in y^e best & speedest man
ner yo^r may: And to rai^se & levy y^e force of y^e Gov^t County to y^e purpose, or any
part thereof, as there shall be cause. And y^e Gov^t hereby require all y^e persons
to beare Armes within y^e Gov^t County, to be obedient unto yo^r, upon such paynes &
penites, as y^e Offence agst Military discipline shall deserve by y^e Law of Armes,
or censure of y^e Provinciale Court. Given at S^t. Maryes this 11th Novemb^r 1646.
