The charge of his L^{td} Attorney agt. Bleach dyed Howells.
 That the said Bleach being to give testimony upon oath, touching a Bull, w^{ch} was in
 controversy between the Baker & the Athem, came voluntarily & made oath in the
 fores^d difference, not being cited by writ. And hath committed a willfull & un-
 lawfull perjury therein.
 And thereupon his L^{td} Attorney requesteth on behalf of the L^{td} People that the
 Bleach may be brought to condigne punishment for the same.
 Upon the fores^d charge of deft. denyal that shee hath committed any such perjury
 & putteth her selfe to be tryed by the Jury. And the Jury returned their verdict
 in writing. Viz. Guilty. And the Court adjudged that the said Bleach shall
 stand in the pillory & lose both her eyes. And this to be executed before
 any other business in Court be proceeded upon.
