manors. Whether or not their forfeitures belonged to W. Lord of W. manors?
The resolution of W. Court was, W. W. forfeitures did of right belong to W. Lord
of W. manors. by virtue of his W. condition of Plantation. The W. uses usually be:
longing to W. Lords of manors in England. And W. Words in W. Patent expressed
viz. All commodities, advantages, emoluments & hereditaments, whatsoever (Royal
jurisdiction excepted) included W. same.
