 habitants thereof. They are to repair to Mr Henry Morgan
 or to the J^{ts} of Kent who together with the commander & the
 other Commissioners of the County shall see them Righted to
 satisfaction since as to them shall seeme Just & convenient.
 And on the contrary likewise upon any complaint for damage re-
 ceived or other aggrievance from the said Indians the English
 are to repair to Tatacoughkew who is to cause satisfaction &
 right to be done & especially for any thing Committed against
 the breach of any the foregoing Articles.

- Thomas Hurston brought before the Govern^r & Councell by
 warrant from Col: Nathaniell Utie Grounded upon the Or-
 der of 23 of July last pleaded he was then at the time of
 the making that order within the Province & consequently not
 within the letter of the Order. Whereupon it was ordered
 that

Whereas there was an order passed this board the 23 of
 July last past, whereby the Justices of Peace were enjoined
 to see all Quakers who are inhabitants of this Province dissuade
 the People from complying with the Orders & commands of the
 Magistrates to be whipt from Constable to Constable & sent
 out of this Province which order related to the time then to
 come. And whereas Thomas Hurston in Obedience to that Or-
 der was by Col: Nathaniell Utie imprisoned to be proceeded
 against accordingly. It appearing to this board that the
 Hurston was then at that time of the making of the said Or-
 der within the Province & consequently not within the letter
 of it. The board doth Judge that the said Hurston be
 for ever banished this Province, & that if he be found within
 this Province at any time 7 days after the date hereof or shall
 at any time after returne againe into this Province that he
 be by the next Justice of the peace caused to be whipt with
 30 lashes & so sent from Constable to Constable till he be con-
 veyed out of the Province. And that if he shall then at any
 time againe presume to returne into this Province that
 he be whipt with 30 lashes at every Constables & be aga-
 ine sent out of the Province as aforesaid. And it is further
