Upon Complaint made by the military officers of the neglect of Mi-
litary Discipline for want of sufficient provision against default-
ers at Musters in theyr last instructions it is ordered

Over Fines
Default: masters

That the Colonells of the Regiments do see that the Musters be
performed as in theyr last instructions & that they doe cause all
defaulters to be fined one hundred pounds of [£] for every de-
fault from this time forward.

Order Delaware Then was taken into Consideracon his Lops Instruction & Command
to send to the Dutch in Delaware bay seated within his Lops Pro-
vince to command them to be gon. & ordered

That Col^l: Nathaniell Stie do make his repaire to the porten-
ted Governor of a People seated in Delaware bay within his Lops
Province & that he do give them to Understand that they are or-
dered within this his Lops Province without Notice Given to his
Lordships Lieutenant here & to require him to depart the
Province.

That in case he find opportunity he intiate into the Peo-
ple there seated that in case they make theyr application to his
Lordships Govern^r: here they shall find good Conditions, touching
to the Con^{di}visions of Plantacon granted to all Comers into this
Province w^{ch} shall be made good to them: & that they shall have
protection in theyr lives, libertys, & estates w^{ch} they shall bring
with them.

The letter of the Govern^r: to the Com-
mander of the People in Delaware bay.

Letter sent by Col^l: I received a letter from you directed to me as the Lord Butler
His to Delaware moves Governor & Lieutenant of the Province of Maryland wherein
you suppose your selfe to be Governor of a people seated in a part
of Delaware Bay w^{ch} I am very well informed lyeth to the south
ward of the degree forty & therefore can by no means owne or ac-
knowledge any for Governor there but my selfe who am by his Lops
appointed Lieutenant of his whole Province lying betwene the
degrees 38 & 40: but do by these require to command you
presently to depart forth of this his Lops Province or otherwise
desire you to hold me excused if I use my utmost endeavour to
reduce that part of his Lops Province unto its due obedience
under him.
