 guese fugitives, All this in Conformity to their Commission
 There are only to serve for their Honor and safe
 Conduct, And We accordingly request that the said
 our Commissioners according to the Right of Nations
 may be credited and believ'd as our trusty Embassadors
 which we in like occasions at all times shall be willing
 to acknowledge, and remain in all other Observations
 which we trust shall be accepted in all cordialty
