 and Avalon Lord Barron of Baltimore of to all the Inhabitants and  
 people in Maryland And to all others without their presents shall come by  
 any way contrary Granting Whereas Josias Bondall late constituted by us  
 our Lieutenant of Maryland hath contrary to his oath and trust  
 to his said office surrendered his Com<sup>ms</sup> from us for the same to a  
 pretended Assembly there and taken it from them, and otherwise  
 raised mutiny and sedition ag<sup>t</sup> our Government and Jurisdiction being  
 knowne yett that wee have revoked and doe revoke and by this  
 presents doe declare that wee doe hereby revoke and absolutely  
 doletermine all former Com<sup>ms</sup> granted unto the said Josias Bondall  
 touching the Govern<sup>mt</sup> of the said Province as alsoe all former  
 Com<sup>ms</sup> to any other person or persons to be of our Council there  
 And have thought fitt to constitute nominate and appoynt to And  
 doe hereby constitute nominate and appoynt to our deare Brother  
 Philip Albert Esq<sup>r</sup> our Lieutenant and thise Governour under us  
 of our said Province Johanes and to hold the same during  
 our pleasure in as ample manner to all intents and purposes  
 as was formerly granted by us unto Captaine William Stone of  
 the said Josias Bondall And wee doe hereby further authorize our  
 said Brother to nominate constitute and appoynt from time to  
 time such and soe many to be of our Council of our said Province  
 as he shall thinke fitt, and to have the like and as ample authority  
 privileges and advantages as those of our Council formerly had there  
 till wee declare our pleasure to be contrary And wee doe further here  
 by authorize our said Brother to appoynt such person or persons for  
 whom he will be responsible as he shall thinke fitt to be our  
~~Lieutenant~~ Secretary and Receiver Generall thereof for the present  
 and our pleasure to further knowe therein and to cause all  
 Rents arrears of Rents and all other dues belonging to us in  
 our said Province to be for our use demanded leavied and  
 paid to our said Receiver soe to be nominated and appoynted  
 by our said Brother and to be afterwards disposed off  
 according to such Instructions, or Directions as wee shall  
 or shall give to him our said Brother for that purpose  
 Given under our hand and greater Seal at Charles the  
 fourth and twelfth day of June in the ninth and twentieth  
 yeare of our Dominion over Maryland And in the year  
 of our Lord God One thousand Six hundred and Sixty.
