 ary 1660.

Proclamation.

By the Governor of Maryland.

Whereas William Fuller commonly known by the
 name of Capt^m Wm Fuller hath for some years bin
 known to be a violent Juroridary and Disturb^r person
 disturbing the Peace of the Province and endeavouring
 the dishonour of his Loy the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary
 thereof,

And forasmuch as the said Wm Fuller doth privately lurk
 and observe himselfe in unknown places I have
 thought fitt to make the same publicly known to
 all persons and therefore require and demand all and
 singular the good people of this Province Sheriffs Con-
 stables and other his Loy Officers both Military and
 Civil to be diligent in inquiring searching for finding
 & apprehending him the said Wm Fuller in all places
 whatsoever whom if they shall happen to take I doe
 hereby further require them that they can be him to
 apprehended to be carryed to the next Justice of the
 Peace whom I doe hereby strictly demand severally
 to keep him in prison, and presently inform some
 one of his Loy Council of his apprehension that so
 he may be safely conveyed to me to St Marys

And I doe hereby further declare and publish that if
 any person or persons after this Proclamation publish
 do receive harbour or maintain him the said Wm
 Fuller, or shall contrive or devise at any means
 whereby he may escape from being taken or arrested
 or shall not use their best endeavours for his apprehen-
 sion as well by giving advertisement as by all other
 good means I shall as there is just cause proceed
 ag^t them with all Severity Given
