 Thomas Gerrard having in that behalf since petitioned  
 our Governour and found for mercy and mitigation of great  
 content knoweth that was by the advise of our said  
 Governour and found he have thought fit and do hereby  
 pardon the said Thomas Gerrard and acquit him of all  
 the crimes of which he was indicted the said twenty seventh  
 day of February last, and also of all and singular expenses  
 and punishment which he had thereby incurred and of which  
 he had judgment the said twenty seventh day of February  
 last. Saving that he shall not at any time hereafter be able  
 to hold Office within the Province, nor have voice in Electing nor be  
 Elected Burgess in any future Generall Assembly of this  
 Province and shall also give Recognizance for his good beha-  
 = viour towards us and our Governour. Here provided always  
 that the said Thomas Gerrard shall not by this our Pardon  
 be intended or construed to be pardoned or acquitted of any  
 of his just debts lawfully due to us or any person who nor of  
 the Sum of one hundred pounds Sterling due to us for parts  
 of a composition for his said Estate nor of the Sum of five  
 thousand pounds of tobacco the remaynder of the said compo-  
 = sition nor of his just dues due to the Sheriffe and other officers  
 of the Court for his imprisonment or otherwise Given at Saint  
 Marys, under the Great Seale of this our Province of Maryland  
 the twenty eighth day of February in the ninth and twentieth  
 years of our Dominion over the said Province of Maryland.
