By whose two Patrollers had named Edward Foster and
John Foster, that John Foster coming in a Canoe towards
the Indians shot at the said Indians and came immediately
away to the Informants house. Whom upon the said Indians
shot & killed at the said Foster and immediately went and
plundered his house and came round about the neck
plundered his tobacco house, where his goods lay for
want of Room in his dwelling house to the value of one
thousand pounds of tobacco. That upon notice given
of this Plunder William Wignall Sr. Foster and Edward
Swanson went forth after the said Indians to know the
reason why they plundered the said tobacco house and
founding up to them in the Woods where they were sitting
round about a fire they immediately surrounded the said
English and discharging a Volley of some shot killed the
said John Foster and at a second Volley wounded William
Wignall, notwithstanding which that they fought them
three hours and made their Retreats good since which
time the said Indians have killed Edward head of Latta-
and hood by head of Rogge; demanding of the Indians who
they were they answered me they were all Sasquahannoughs
at all Indians used to do the same to his house

The marks of Mr. T. Taylor
The Informants of Thomas Overton and William Scalls
Daye that about the 29th of April last Thomas Campion
and Richard Sayde seeing two Canoes with 9 Delaware
Bay Indians coming down Bush River, watching their
Canoes did discern that they steered towards their
plantation upon which the said Campion and Richard Sayde
came and brought the Informants news of their coming.
Soe upon that they took to their Boats and Skins and
went to the Indians and required of them what they
would Sasquahannoughs you, or not, and they answered
No; And whilst that these Informants were talking wth
one of the said Campions in one of the Canoes the other
Canoe with Indians went a Shore, And as soon
as the said they were on the Shore, one of the Informants
Dogs seized on one of the said Indians, and upon that
the Indian turned him about and shot the Dog and
killed it, And immediately another of the said Indians
