 Messengers Betwene yo. and us according to Charter And be sure
 to advise us of every accident of importance; that shall befall
 yo. or the Sasquahannocks, and of the proceedings of our affairs

4 Yo. are carefully to informe yo. selfe of the progress of the Warre
 betwene them and the Cinagou Indians, and if yo. finde them slack
 in it, to presse them directly to a vigorous prosecution of it.

5 Yo. are carefully to abode all Quarrels with the Indians and
 therefore permit not the Soldiers, to sit drinking or gaming w.
 them, but keep them to exact military discipline and to abode
 Idleness often exercise them.

6 Make diligent Enquiry touching the Murderers of the Roman
 in Cataquo woods, and of John Nordon and his companions
 their way from Dolewars Bay or. And if yo. finde by hand
 any of the said Murderers in the Circle Sea then shall be deate
 or send them downe to be to be proceeded against according to our
 Lawes

7 Lastly yo. are to have a very wary Eye upon all Duties that come
 to this Shore, observing their Actions, and to watch wite the
 Indians, but show not any animosity against them, if yo. finde
 any those contrivances to our judgement give us speedy notice and
 opposite discretion any open at home feyned, tend to our
 Loss.
