yo. shall thinke convenient to muster and traine up
at they may be in a readynes as occasion shall require
and my further commands, with fitting honor and
for the purpose aforesaid to have and to hold the
office and command till the Lord Proprietary his heirs
his or their Lieutenant their Governor or Captaine General
for the tyme being shall signify his or their pleasure to
the contrary, And all persons whatsoever are herby
commanded and required to yo. and all due obedience.
