You shall Swear that as Commission in the County of St. Marys
 in all Articles in his Majesty's Commission to you directed you shall do
 Right to the poor as to the rich to the best of your running
 and power, and after the precedents and Customs of this Province
 and Acts of Assembly thereto made And that you shall hold
 Sessions or Courts as you are directed in your Commission or otherwise
 of Assembly providing in that behalf, And all Oaths and
 =ments that shall happen to be made and all forfeitures which
 shall be made you shall cause to be entered without any delay
 and certify the same to his Majesty's Justice of this Province you shall
 not debate, or hinder the prosecution of Justice or take any Gifts
 Bribes or fees to the intent to delay Judgment But shall behave
 yourself justly and truly to the best of your understanding and power
 So long as you shall persist in this Office, and until you shall be
 by lawfull Authority discharged therefrom And you shall
 Swear that you will not by yourself, nor any other person directly
 nor indirectly trouble molest or discourage any person who
 =ever in this Province professing to believe in Jesus Christ for or
 in Respect of his or her Religion nor in his or her free exercise
 thereof within the said Province Soe as they be not contrary
 to his said Majesty nor molest or conspire against the Civil Government
 Established here under him Soe he has you God.
