Then was called John Everett to answer for his
 contempt in running from his fellow Soldiers that
 he would not be art Armes ag^t the Spaniards for
 conscience sake. Ordered that the said John
 Everett be committed to the custody of Nicholas
 Juyther till 27th of November next and that Leon
 he be tried by a Court Marshall And that Capt
 John Collier & one then to testify in his case being
 the man that pressed the said Everett.
