 should use or might use or exercise by virtue of  
 our Com. granted to him for that purpose  
 bearing date the fourth and twentieth day of  
 June one thousand six hundred and fifty six  
 that our said Brother do still continue and  
 remaine our Chanceller and Keeper of our  
 great Seale there, And wee doe further  
 hereby authorize and appoynted our said dear  
 Brother Philip Calvert to be Deputy Lieutenant  
 of the said Province under our said dear friend  
 and to be the first of our Councill there and  
 in the absence of our said friend out of the said  
 Province to be our Lieutenant there as formerly  
 provided allwayes that our said dear friend  
 doe take in open Court in our said Province  
 out of our Lieutenant to be administered unto  
 him by the Deputy Lieutenant Secretary for  
 any two of our Councill there whom wee doe  
 hereby authorize and require to administer  
 by same according to before he sitt or Act as our  
 Lieutenant of the said Province given under our  
 Hand and Great Seale at Arundel the fourth  
 = tenth day of September in the thirtieth yere  
 of our dominion over Maryland and in the  
 yere of our Lord 1661
