

At a Council hold at St. Margo 20th of November 1661

Then was called for Capt. John Dobie to give an Account
 in writing according to the order of the last part of his
 proceedings with the Sasquia Harbour Co. But
 appeared not.

Then was called John Everett to answer his Complaint
 in running from his fellow when first to go to the
 Sasquia Harbour Co. He pleads that he cannot
 do that Service for Conscience sake.

Ordered that the said Everett be tryed at the next
 Provincial Court and in the interim be committed into
 the Sheriffs hands and that the Sheriffs impanel
 a Jury against that time and in the meantime
 the said Everett to be kept in Prison and to eat his
 own Bread.

Ordered that Richard Willo and George Stye be
 brought by the Sheriffs to the next Provincial
 Court to answer in not sending letters down to
 the Governor according to the Act of Assembly
 and for contemptuously staying up a letter of
 the Sheriffs directed to the Governor as aforesaid.
