A Proclamation

Prohibiting Trade with the Indians without
License and for prohibiting exportation
of Corn out of the Province.

Whereas by Act of the General Assembly made
at St. Johns the 27th day of April last it was
Enacted that no person shall trade with any
Indians of this Province or goe through any river
of this Province to trade with any Indians to the
Northward of this Province without License of his
Maj^{ty} or of his Governor of this Province for the time
being upon payne of forfeiture to his Maj^{ty} of all
Commodities unlawfully traded for and all Vessels
and Boats unlawfully traded with: This is
Therefore to be proclaimed that if doe hereby revoke
and determine all former Licenses and Licenses
to trade by any Governor of this Province given and
straightly to Charge and Command all Officers and
other persons what so ever to seize the Boats
Vessels or Boats or other Commodities of any persons
unlawfully trading contrary to that Act, and
them soe seized to bring to St. Marys there to be
adjudged And further to give notice that if any
person shall seize any Boat Vessel or Boat
of any person unlawfully trading as aforesaid and
