

Trade for any Commodity from any such Indian or
 Indians as aforesaid or other Inhabitant of this
 Province he doo not exporte the same out of this
 Province without License first had and obteyned from
 our Lieutenant or other Chiefe Governour of this
 Province Provided alsoe the said William Bollins
 shall pay to the Lord Proprietary or his heires the
 tenth in weight or value of all Commoditys traded
 for with the Indians either by himselfe or any other
 person intrusted by him and full full all such Commoditys
 as are specified in that Acte concerning Trade
 with the Indians, Given under the great Seale of
 our said Province of Maryland this ninth day of
 December in the thirthe year of our Dominion over
 the said Province of Maryland Anno domini 1661
