Upon Information that John Jonkmo formerly Capt. John
Jonkmo who rayssed the mutiny in Charles County in
February last and hath since been for the said fact
prosecuted to an Outlawry, is returned against into the
Province and further aboute Wicoromato River and
Sitawapon and that he hath been seized at the house
of Josias Kendall and Christopher Russell and that
Arthur Turner is suspected of complicity in
said Jonkmo and his Complices. Ordered that
Jonkmo and Russell be forthwith apprehended
committed to prison at St. Marys without Bayle
Mayprise. That the said Josias Kendall be removed
to his house till further order from the Board and
that Capt. James Noale do send for the said Turner
and cause him to finde two sufficient Suretyes for
his good abearance or else to commit him to the Stocks
and that the Chancellor do send his order to fort
putt in Execution.

Pacillus or To all persons to whom the
Sents shall come greeting in our Lord God everlasting
knowe yet that woe exposing unto truste confidence
in the care diligent and Integrity of John Nuttall
willing to comply with him in his request, desire
doe hereby give and Grant to him the said John
Nuttall Libertye out and com: to trade with
the Inhabitants of the Province, for any Beavers
Furres, Skins, or any other Commoditye whatsoever
and to that end it shall be hereby lawful for him
said John Nuttall to pass upon or through any river
