

Brooke or other passage through any parts of
 this Province to be done for any such Commodityes
 with any Indian or Indian without His Province
 or exports to the same from hence to the
 said John Nuttall shall like fit or convenient
 Provided that if he the said John Nuttall shall buy
 or trade for any Commodity from any such Indian or
 Indian as aforesaid he do not export the same
 out of this Province without License first had and
 obtained from our Lord and his Chiefe Governour of
 this Province Provided alsoe that y^e said John Nuttall
 pay to the said Proprietary or his heirs the true
 part in weight or value of all Commodityes soe
 soe traded for either by himselfe or any other person
 intrusted by him; and fulfill all such Conditions as
 are expressed in that att^e concerning Trade with
 Indians, And wee hereby authorize and impower him
 the said John Nuttall to take seize or surprize the person
 or persons, Boats, vessels or Truck of any trading in
 any parts of this Province without License of us or our
 heirs or our or their Lieutenant or Chiefe Governour
 for the time being And wee doo hereby will and
 require him the said John Nuttall in his Custody safely
 to keep the person, Boats, vessels or Truck of any
 person taken soe trading without License untill they
 shall be brought to a legall tryall before our Justice
 or Chiefe Governour of this Province for the time being
 Provided that this License unto the said John Nuttall
 for trading with the Indians shall not be in force
 but untill the first day of January next ensuing the
 day hereof Given under the great seale of our said Province
 of Maryland this 24th day of January in the 30th year of
 our Dominion over this Province among dominions 1661
