The humble petition of Hannah for Widd  
Sheweth

That y<sup>e</sup> said Hannah promised y<sup>e</sup> Honore to keep  
Ordinary this Generall Assembly touching And  
having not bene to mayntayne her said promise

She humbly desires y<sup>e</sup> Honore to  
grante her a licence to trade with y<sup>e</sup>  
Indians for some bene to make provision  
according

And she as in duty bound go.

Upon the petition abovesaid It is ordered that  
the said Hannah sh<sup>e</sup> have a licence granted to  
trade with the Indians, as is desired for forme  
only.

Ordered that Moyse Stagnell be Shouffe of  
Salbott County still the fourth Co. & can neede to  
present of his p<sup>er</sup>sons to the Governour & Council
