

To which they replied that when they had prepared houses and prepared other necessaries for an Emperor then they would com to the Lieutenant Generall and desire him to place the sayde Wanasappin in the possession of the Empire over them. ordered that the Mangicomaco of Piscatoway doe prepare all things necessary ready for reception of wanasappin and that when they have all things ready the Mangicomaco doe give notice to the Lieutenant Generall that hee may appoint a time to place him in the possession of the Governmt.

At a Council held at Carto backe present Lieutenant General Deputy Lieutenant and Chancellor, and Robert Charles Esq^r.
Commissioner

Came Henry Hudson owner of the Barke Expedition of Piscatoway in New England, which sayd Barque was seized by order from the Govern^{or} and Council vppon the late Act for navigation and increase of shippinge and made oath that his sayde Barque was of new England built, and that hee himselfe is sole owner of her. where vppon it was objected ag^t him that hee had shipped Tobacco on board before hee had entred in Bond according to the Act of Navigation or shewed Certificat that hee had in any other place entred into such Bond as aforesd. the evidence beinge cleare that noe Tobacco was shipped on Board before seizure. ordered that the vessel be delivered up to the J^r Hudson againe, but that for his neglect of runninge to st. Marys accordinge to the Proclamation for better observation of the Act of Navigation hee defray the whole charge of seizinge and secureinge the vessel, viz^t To Luck Barber 1000 of tobacco, to James Lynsey 50^l. to Mr. Mountague 50^l. To Mr. Manson 50. John Chaveman 50. Sam. Harris 100 Thomas Stambidge 100. miles Glouers 50. Thom. Wentworth 50. and that the sayd Hudson doe putt in sufficient Security for to appeere at st. Marys there to enten into bond accordinge to the Act of navigation and increase of shippinge, and that till such security be given as aforesd. and that Doctor Barber and the men by him employed for secureinge of the vessel in this order mentioned be satisfi^d. Doctor Luck Barber is heere by impowred to detaine the sayd vessel. ordered further that Enay Enoch Doughty be brought downe to st. Marys there to make oath concerning certaine unlawfull goods, alledged to be aboard the sayd vessel, and that Doctor Barber doe give him notice here of.
