May 23^o. 1662 M^r. William Auer^t Licence to trade with the Indians dated May the 5^o. 1662, to stand in force till the first of January next. Hee gave bond to the Lieut^{nt} Generall according the com^{on} forme.

May ditto die At a County Court held at Seuerne for the County of Ann Arundell November the 11^o. 1661. present Edward Lloyd Esq^r Cuncellor Samuel Whit withers, M^r Robert Burle, Roger Grosse Thomas Todd Edmond Townhill Commissioners.

Whereas Captain John Collier came this day to the Courte, certifyinge the Court of his inability of body to take a journey at present downe to the Provinciall Court without greate hazard and endangeringe of his health, desiringe that the Courte would heere take his deposition, beinge at present not fitt nor able to goe downe, but is ready if there be further occasion for his appearance to give his attendance at the Provinciall Court when hee shall be there unto required, the Court therefore consideringe his present condition, hath taken his Affidavit, and hath imboundened them to certifie the same to your hon^{rs}.

Cap^{tn}. John Collier aged 33 years or thereabouts sworne in Court that John Auer^t beinge prest by your Deponent appeared accordinge to order at the place of Rendezvous, and then alleged hee could not beare the same by reason of tendernes of conscience, whereupon one John Lacey professed
