 of John Nuttall And willing to Comply with his
 in his request & desire Doe hereby give & graunt
 to him the said John Nuttall Liberty License an
 Commission to trade with any the Inhabers
 of this Province for any Beavers furs skins
 or any other Commodities whatsoever. And to
 end it shall be hereby lawful for him the
 John Nuttall to pass upon or through any
 or Creeke or other Passage through any
 of this Province to trade for any such Commodities
 with any Indian or Indians without this Province
 and to Reporte the same from time to time
 as hee the said John Nuttall shall thinke fitt
 Conuement Provided that if hee the said John Nuttall
 shall buy or trade for any Corne from any such
 or Indians as aforesaid Hee doe not export the same
 of this Province without License first had obtain
 from o. Lieutenant or Chiefe Governour of this Province
 Provided also that the said John Nuttall pay to o.
 Lord Proprietary or his heires the tenth part
 weight or value of all Commodities whatsoever
 traded for either by himselfe or any other person
 intrusted by him selfe fullfill all such Conditions
 are expressed in that Act concerning trade w.
 the Indians &c. Doe hereby authorize & impow
 him the said John Nuttall to take Cixe or Surge
 the person or persons Boates vessels or truckes of any
 trading in any part of this Province within the
 of us or o. heires or our or their Lieutenant or Chiefe
 Governour for the tyme being and Hee doe hereby
 and require him the said John Nuttall to
