 they shall bee brought to a legall tryall before our Lieutenent
 or cheife Governour of this Province for the tyme being -
 Provided that this Lycence unto the said John Nuttall
 for trading with the Indians shall not bee in force -
 but until the twenty thirde day of January next -
 ensuing the date hereof. Given under the great Seale
 of our said Province of Maryland this twenty thirde
 day of January in the One & thirtieth yeare of our
 Dominion over this Province Anno Domini
 One thousand six hundred sixty two Withnesse
 our deare Sonne & heire Charles Calvert Esq^r
 Our Lieutenent Generall of our said Province of
 Maryland

Wherces I am informed that certaine Sloopes &
 other Vessells come into yo^r County & transport
 away Tob. before they enter their Sloopes, contrary
 to yo^r Act of navigation, & the Act order & lawes
 here established. These are therefore in his M^{ty}
 name to authorize yo^r to examine all & every
 person attending in any Sloope or other Vessell carrying
 & attempting to export Tob. & not shewing Certificate
 of their Entry here, That then within ^{the} ten dayes at
 least yo^r cause them to putt in good sufficient securi:
 ty that wth in Ten dayes at least they come eyther
 before yo^r Lieut. Governour, of this Province, or the
 Secretary, & there make Entry of such Sloope
 or other Vessell as afores^d. And if in case you
 find any that have loaded any Tob. aboard their
 Vessells, & not shewing Certificate of such their
 Entry That then yo^r seize the same, & cause
 both the Vessell together wth the Tob. soe seized
 by yo^r, to bee conveyed & brought unto yo^r Lieut.
 Governour, to bee by him & the Councell determined
