The Bond for those to give who have Comisⁿ
to trade wth Indians.

This day came Capt. Will^m Boorem Gent. & acknow-
ledged himselfe unto J^r Hon^{ble} J^r Prop^r of this Pro-
vince in y^e w^{it} & full sume of five hundred pounds sterl.
of lawfull money of England to be payd ut or afore y^e
day of next ensuing the date hereof. in
Case hee J^r William Boorem shall not come & yield
up a p^{er}fect & true account of y^e Tenth part in weight
or value of all Commodities whatsoever traded for with any
Indian or Indians whatsoever either by himselfe or any
other p^{er}son intrusted by him unto J^r Prop^r of this Pro-
vince or his heyrns, or his or their Lieut^t or Chief^t Gov^r
for y^e time being. or any other Officer or Officers by him
or them impowred thereto, when hee thereunto shall bee
lawfully called. And in Case hee doth trade for any Com^o
hee doe not export y^e same out of this Province wth out
License first had & obtayned from y^e Lieut^t or Chief^t Gov^r
for y^e time being. And doe not fulfill all such Condi-
cons as are expressed in y^e last Act Concerning Trade wth
Indians. For y^e w^{ch} paymt^t well & truly to be made and
done hee J^r Will^m Boorem doth bind himselfe his heyrns
Dece. Adm^t & assigns firmly by these p^{er}ents. & doth
herunto sett his hand & Seale this 25. day of March 1663.
