

That every Officer military doe from time to time sende  
 Intelligence to y<sup>e</sup> Major Lieut Col or Col of y<sup>e</sup> respective  
 Regiments of the said Major Lieut Col or Col doe from  
 time to time send Intelligence to y<sup>e</sup> Governour & Council  
 if they keepe a Correspondence one with another  
 And whereas there is a Quezo Indian taken prisoner  
 in Tappan River who alledges he came to seeke a peace  
 and brought a present intended to us of Sasquah-  
 hanough Indians ordered y<sup>e</sup> the said Indian to be  
 for down to S<sup>t</sup>. Marys & kept in prison of a  
 Letter written to you will stay <sup>us</sup> to request him to  
 give notice to y<sup>e</sup> <sup>trading at fort range</sup> Quezoes if we have such a prisoner  
 whom we shall keep a while till we see whether they  
 desire a peace really or not because no present come  
 of if they desire not a peace as hee alledges y<sup>e</sup> we  
 shall put him to death of Jacob Clauson doe give notice  
 to y<sup>e</sup> Sasquahhanough Indians of this our Intention &  
 require them to declare whether they <sup>are</sup> willing to  
 submit in this Message till wherof answer ~~shall~~  
 shall be deferred.

# Proclamation

By the Honourable Governour

Whereas several murders & outrages have been  
 lately committed upon several English of this country by  
 y<sup>e</sup> Quezoes or Jonado Indians & that they doe daily  
 make invasions into this province We doe hereby  
 publish & declare y<sup>e</sup> ~~of~~ Quezoes or Jonado  
 to be enemies & as such to be regarded & treated  
 by all persons hereby declaring it to be lawfull  
 for any person inhabiting in this province to kill  
 slay or take prisoner any of y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Quezoes
