

with sufficient Arms and Ammunition as aforesaid &
and also to proceed in what he shall hereafter be
acted, and according to former Orders —
And as the Commanders in Chief shall see good
to press and raise more men for the going
forward of his designs —

And that the now Commissioned Captains for
Kent County, do press and raise some men
in that County, besides one to be by him
appointed for their Officer with sufficient foot
Arms and Ammunition that is two pounds of
powder and five pounds of shot with provisions
or Boats to transport them to Capt William
Burgis of Anne Arundell County, here of
him to receive further Orders his Commander
in Chief of the said forces aforesaid —

Ordered that John Cobrty be Commissioned
Captaine for that Company on the Plains —

Ordered that George Reed be Commissioned
Captaine for that Company about Leonard Creek

Whereupon
Com^{con} issued for Cap^t George Reed to be Captaine
of all the forces from Leonard Creek to the
Cours on the Northside of Delawent River and
from his own plantation to Cedar Point on the
Southside of the said river according to the forme
of a Com^{con} for a Cap^t of foot given to Cap^t Evans
folio 23 appears given and my hand and Seale this
6th day of June 1665 —
