 Governor or Capt. Generall for y^e time being
 shall signify his or their pleasure to y^e Contrary
 And all persons what so ever and hereby
 charged & required to yield all due Obedience to
 yo^r said Lord's Lieut^{nt} in all things appertaining
 to y^e Command of Office hereby conferred on yo^r
 and they will answer y^e Contrary at their peril
