Came Wastanona Harigwora & Godwongwora
 two Captains of the Sasquahannock and
 desired the continuance of their wages as of the
 High Honor the Lord Prop: and protesting that
 they were always ready to have delivered
 Wastanona up to the Justice of his Lord's for
 murdering the men at the mill in Baltimore County
 and desiring that the Willing of one man may not
 be imputed against the whole
 Nation and requesting the assistance of the
 Governour now at this time having lost the con-
 siderable number of men in ranging the head
 of Patuxent and the other rivers so to secure
 the English Plantations from the Incursions
 and remonstrating that the Incursions are resolved
 to storm the Sasquahannock fort in danger
 next and that afterwards the said Incursions intend
 to fall upon the English in this Province

Whereupon was begun a further treaty of peace
 with the Sasquahannock in which was included
 as follows
