

Articles of Peace and Amity concluded
 upon by His Hon^{ble} Charles Calvert Esq^r Govern^r
 of His Crowne of Maryland on the behalfe
 of His R^{ight} Hon^{ble} His Lord Proprietary of
 His said Crowne of His One Party
 And Wastanunda Harigwara & Goswong-
 beruckwa were Captains of y^e Sasquaha-
 =noughs Nation His R^{ight} Hon^{ble} Deputy Govern^r
 of His Other Party

Imprimis That His Sasquahannock Indians shall deliver
 Wanahodana that killed His English man at
 His mill if ever he returns out of Captivity
 from His Indians, And for His future that
 they shall apprehend them and deliver up
 to His Govern^r of His Crowne for His time
 being any Indian whatsoever that shall kill
 any English man And that as soon as they
 shall come to know of it And as it will
 be in their power to apprehend And that without
 demand made by His English -

2^dly - That every Indian that shall hereafter kill any hoggs
 or Cattle of His English and shall thereof be
 convicted shall pay for every hogg fifty fathom
 of Beake and for every head of any other
 sort of Cattle One hundred fathom of Beake
 for Satisfaction to His Owners of every
 such Coast -

3^dly - That all former Crimes Committed by any Indian
 of that Nation shall be forgot & buried in
 Oblivion except Murder of any English
 not yet discovered
