On the 12th of Sept 1666

There was taken into Consideration the making up
of the publique Treasury for this present year of 1666

It was ordered that the Lieutenant Governor
be paid out of the publique Treasury for a horse by him
distributed and given by the Country to the Indians 2500
also ordered the Lieutenant Governor be paid out of the
publique Treasury for Carpenters work & plank used
in and the Court house for the rails & benches of } 1920

Also ordered the Lieutenant Governor be paid out
of the publique Treasury for Carpenters & other needs
of the Court house — — — — — } 2020

Ordered that the Hon^{ble} Chamberlain be paid out of
the publique Treasury the charge of his Hoope's own
to the Governor at his house with carrying of money wages } 2000

Ordered that the said Daniel Denner be paid
out of the publique Treasury for making up the
publique Treasury 3 years together of County Treasury } 2000

Ordered that the said Daniel Denner be paid
out of the publique Treasury for 2 mens hire and
wages what ever he should have about the Office to
the late Secretary } 940

Ordered that Lieutenant Governor be paid
out of the publique Treasury for Carpenters
work and Plank distributed about the Office
to the late Secretary } 3402

There was read a petition of divers Inhabitants of
of Charles County that the Governor would displace Capt
Bordenman whom was lately constituted Capt of the militia

Ordered that the 5th first named in the said petition be
sent for down by speciall summons to the Sheriff of that
County, to appear at the Court of the said County
on the 10th of November next for disobeying the said Com^{mission}
names and demands and for the said Com^{mission} officers
in or on the said County
