

Further Ordered that Proclamation be issued throughout the province (viz) that the wicked and malicious Indians be declared to be and reputed enemies to the inhabitants of this province as well as all other Indians that shall receive harbour or entertain them

Also Ordered that Lt Col Smyth be satisfied for his charge in keeping in custody the said 4 Indians and their guard, out of the publick Treasury 1295^l 10^s and 490^l 10^s more of the Governour & Chamberlains who take to their own use the three young Indians last named and pay the said charge for the Country the Old Indian being first named to be forthwith Executed

Charles Calvert Esq^r Capt General of all the Forces within this Province of Maryland under the Right Hon^{ble} Cecilus Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the same To Major Thomas Ingram of Talbot County greeting According to the power do Me by his said Lt Col committed and upon the speciall trust and confidence I have in your fidelity courage and good conduct I do hereby constitute Ordaine and appoint you Major and Commander in Me of all the Forces that at present are raised or which hereafter shall be raised or done in under your Command to march in any expedition against all such Indians as are or shall be declared to be enemies and reputed such to the inhabitants of this Province Rescoking and annulling by these presents all former Commissions or Constitutions made by me to any person or persons whatsoever relating or tending to any Command or Office in the said March or Expedition against the above said enemy Giving and Granting to you the said Major Thomas Ingram full power and authority to Depute Ordaine and appoint such and so many Officers as shall be requisite necessary and of ability to Officers under your Command which said power and Command so by you deputed Ordained or appointed by virtue hereof shall be as firm and effectual to all intents and purposes as if the said Commission did give from me with the like power to the said Officer or Officers provided always that such Commissions be never so given by you exceed not the limits of your own or contrary to such directions Orders or Instructions as I do herewith send or which hereafter you shall from time to time receive from Me which forces above mentioned you are hereby required to muster organize and draine up in the Art of warre and in military discipline and in all things to doe as any Major of a Regiment may or of Right ought to doe in the resistance of all enemies suppression of all tumults insurrections in surrections and rebellions whatsoever And to that end to list such and so many of the inhabitants of your County and all others that shall come in under your Command as you shall thinke fit and necessary and them so listed when and as often as you shall thinke convenient to muster and draine so that they may be in all Readynesse at any time shall require to attend my further Commands with fitting Armes and ammunition for the expedition and purpose aforesaid To have and to hold the said Office and Command till the said Proprietary his Lieutenant or Capt General for the time being shall
