Also in said Com^{con} is appointed John Gittings Clerk of the Records in the said County Court of Calvert which said Courts are to be kept on such days as is appointed by the Act of Assembly in such Cases provided

Charles Calvert Esq^r Governour of all the forces in this province of Maryland and of the ~~the~~ Calvert Esq^r Governour according to the power to mee by his said Lopp Comitted and upon y^e speciall trust and Confidence shewen you y^e fidelity circumspection courage and good Conduct I doe hereby constitute Ordaine and Appoint you Comand^r in cheife and in chief of all the forces that at y^e Tont are raised or which hereafter shall be raised or come in and y^e Comand to march in this Province at present intended in Calvert County against any Indians there and or shall be declared to be knowne or reputed Enemies to the Inhabitants of this province, giving and granting to you the said Charles Calvert full power and Authority to dispute ordaine and appoint such and so many officers as shall be accordingly qualified and of ability to officiate and y^e Comand, which said power or Comand I doe by y^e given by vertue hereof shall be as from and effectuall to all intents and purposes as if the same in the like power should immediately derive from mee to the said officers as aforesaid, which forces above mentioned you are hereby required to muster Exercise and traine up in y^e order of warre and military discipline and in all things to be as any Comand^r in Chiefe may or of right ought to do to the assistance and destruction of all Enemies
