It was further ordered that Baltimore Talbot and
Somerset County's should provide these provisions following
but not warranted as yet for y^e execution of the Order

Major George Smyth & Co. to provide 15 Barrels of Corn & 2200
weight of meat out of Baltimore County
Stephen Berry & Co. to provide 10 Barrels
of Corn & 1500 weight of meat out of Somerset County
two persons named Commissary for y^e providing of 25 Barrels of
Corn and 3000 weight of meat out of Talbot County &
reason it should be ordered upon y^e Governor's arrival there

The foregoing were to the officers for the raising
of men and to the Commissarys for providing provisions
it as followeth (viz) -

Immediately upon sight hereof y^e are to raise three and
twenty men out of y^e own Company well armed & clothed
that is to say, such men wth a good first gunn a sword
two pound of powder six pound of shot & four flints -
and in case any servant or hired person shall be so minded by
y^e and not capable of furnishing himself as aforesaid -
the master of such person or servant is to provide the
same for his said servant or hired person, otherwise to appear
himself wth the said Arms and Ammunition At y^e and to
cause every of y^e men to provide & bring wth him one falling
axe, which said three & twenty men y^e are to have ready at
one hours warning after which y^e are to apply y^e self
to Geo. Dent & Robt. Sly Commissarys for y^e providing Pro-
visions in St Mary's County and when they shall assure
y^e that two months provisions (according to y^e warrant to them
directed) is on board a good Schooner fitt for y^e transportation
of your said men then y^e are to come wth y^e said men to
Past St Mary's being a place of y^e General Rendezvous & wth
three days provisions in Knapsacks there to attend my
further Orders given and I have this to do wth of Feb: 1664
