Whereas we the Lieutenant

to whom this proclam: shall come greeting —
Know yet that we in Consideration of the Naturall love and affection whic: we have unto
and of the singular Duty and faithfull Service, so us by our Districtors and welbeloved son
Charles Calvert Esq: Rutherford done and performed, and hereafter to be done and performed —
And for the serviceal Crust and Confidence, whic: we haue in his great Troubles and
Consort and fidelity of our said Deare sonne, haue given and granted And we do by these
presente give and grant unto our said Deare sonne, the Office of Lieutenant Generall
Chif: Captain: Chif: Governor and Comander and Chif: Admirall both by Sea
and of our Province of Maryland in the parts of America and of all our Islands —
Territoryes and Dominiones, whatsoeuer in any the parts of America, thenceunto belonging —
And of all and singular our other fforts fortresses, fortifications Munitiones shippes
and Navies in our said Province Islands Territoryes and Dominiones aforesaid, And also the
Custody and Chif: Governour and Comander of our said Province Islands Territoryes and
Dominiones aforesaid, and of all and singular the other fforts fortresses fortifications
Munitiones shippes & Navies within our said Province Islands Territoryes and Dominiones
aforesaid bring and bringing or to be and remaine, and to us in any wise belonging or
appertaining together with all our singular the Rights, Priviledges, Juridictions Comodities
Advantage and Emoluments whatsoever, to the said Office and Government, or either of them
any wise belonging or appertaining, And him the said Rutherford we do make or cause
and constitute Lieutenant Generall, Chif: Captain: and Chif: Admirall both by Sea and
Land Chif: Governor and Comander of our said Province Islands Territoryes and Dominiones
And of all the fforts Navies shippes plancs and things aforesaid by these presentes
have hold occupy enjoy and exercise the said Office of Lieutenant Generall Chif: Captain:
and Chif: Admirall Chif: Governor and Chif: Comander aforesaid with his opportunity
unto our said Deare sonne Rutherford by himselfe or by his sufficient Deputy or
Deputyes by him in his absence to be appointed during our pleasure. And we do likewise
for the Considerations aforesaid, give and grant unto our said Deare sonne full power
and authority during the time of his exercise of the said Office before mentioned by him
and his Capitaines and Officers by him to be appointed, to say Murther and Treayse
sorts of men of what Condition or where so ever bound in our said Province and
Dominion for the time being remaining, And in case of Injurie couraffault or appre-
of any Enemy or Enemys Pyrate or Pyrates or other Robbers, to make warre and to
punish such Enemy or Enemys Pyrate or Robber aforesaid by Sea at Land and
and take them and bring so taken to put them to death by the law of Warre.
