

came on board the said Ketch, I saw Lord Falbott most inhumanly
 load'd with Iron, and requiring the reason of the Capt. he told me

 upon which discourse came on board the Hon^{ble} Lord Henry -
 Darrell, and May: Nicholas Swall two of the Deput. Govern^{ors}
 and the R^{ts} Hon^{ble} the Lord Brophy and did then and there demand
 the body of the said Falbott in the name of my Lord Brophy to be
 deliver'd to them in order to receive his tryall, and that Justice
 might be done according to Law, to which Allen reply'd he
 knew not the name of the Lord Brophy nor would obey any
 One in or under that name, nor no other name but of King,
 to which the said Govern^{ors} or one of them made answer that
 they came in no other name nor by any other Authority but
 what was deriv'd from the King or words to that effect,
 and thereupon produced a Copy of my Lords Charter, but not
 withstanding severall reasons were made for the delivery of
 the said Falbott, Allen refus'd the delivery of him, and for
 the said Deput. Govern^{or} was a shoard, afterwards the said
 Allen caus'd us to stay to drink a bowl of punch with him,
 which this Deput. did, the said Allen say'd that now my Lords
 Charter was not worth a pin, and that there was a great many
 of hungry Courtiers that would jump at the news of Kousby's
 death, being killed by the hands of Lord Falbott, being a man
 intrusted by my Lord, and that it was no doubt but they would
 do my Lords business with the King, and soon after this Deput.
 went ashoard. After which this Deput. had occasion to go into
 Virginia, and at the house of Ralph Wormley Esq. this Deput. met
 with the said Allen, and the said Allen say'd that notwithstanding
 all that Maryland could do, he had brought Falbott along
 with him, This Deput. made answer none in Maryland judg'd
 would in the least hinder it, the said Allen made answer it
 was well they did not, for if any had, he would not spare
 man woman nor child, but lay the whole Country desolate,
 and further the said Allen say'd he doubted not but that he
