

This lastly this Informant sayth, that ^{the} said what he hath already affirmed to be true, It is true also that said Murderer, hath been for the greater part of his time since his said escape, in his own house, or in or about the house or place aforesaid, and there hath done and now doeth by assistance of his confederate App: watch and ward at the place and house aforesaid. And that although this Informant is owner of a frontier plantation, and had in that respect arms belonging to the County, which were delivered to this Informant by the said Old Falbot as he before having command and the App: the said Arms, that is to say a Carabine was demanded of this Informant by one Garrett, Couru or I want to the S: Falbot, or to leave it at Mr: Oldfield's house at the day and place aforesaid, and this Garrett did at the same time desire this Informant to acquaint Edward Johnson another Inhabitant also of a frontier plantation living in the Carabine to the place and at the time aforesaid which Old Falbot had formerly delivered them.

March 5th 1684: This Information was sworn to in Council by the Informant *J. Cullen* (the Informant signed)

Whereupon It was thought fit and convenient and likewise ordered by this Board that special warrants issue to the Sheriffs of Cecil and Baltimore Counties, authorizing and empowering as also strictly charging and commanding them and all other their Agents civil and military within the said Counties and others the good people thereof to make diligent search and inquiry in and about all places within their respective Counties both by land and water for the said Falbot and his confederates or either of them and them or them whosoever be found further with concealing & secretly conveying to the said Council at City of St. Maries with all speed by according to the good practice.
