Whereas for several right and urgent occasions and affairs  
relating to the R. Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Gov<sup>or</sup> of this Province, and the defence  
of this said Province, the said Gov<sup>or</sup> did by Proclamation bearing date  
the eighth day of July 1682: Declare the calling of a new Assembly  
to begin and holden at the City of St. Marks the twentieth day  
of October then next following, which said Assembly was by  
Proclamation bearing date the ninth day of September 1682:  
prorogued until the four and twentieth day of October then next  
following, and from thence by Proclamation bearing date the said  
four and twentieth day of October was prorogued until the six  
and twentieth day of the said Month, which accordingly there with  
and held at the City of St. Marks, and there continued until the  
seventeenth day of November 1682: and was from thence further  
prorogued until the first Sunday in March 1682: which upon the  
three and twentieth day of January 1682: was prorogued until  
the eighth day of May 1683: And from thence by proclamation  
bearing date the third day of April 1683: prorogued until the  
fourth day of September 1683: And from thence by Proclamation  
bearing date the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ prorogued to the  
October 1683: which accordingly there with and held  
at the house of John Larkin at the Ridge in St. Marks County  
and there continued until the sixth day of November following,  
and from thence adjourned to the first day of April last past, which  
accordingly there with at the City of St. Marks, and there continued  
until the six and twentieth day of the said April, and from  
thence prorogued to the first Sunday in April 1685: and now  
not refusing; which said first Sunday in April is now passing  
over us: the said Assembly should again sitt being now under a  
hand, and no urgent occasions or affairs relating to the State  
or welfare of this said Province appearing for the convening or  
sitting of the said Assembly on the said first Sunday in April  
next ensuing. We have by and with the advice and consent of  
the said Council determined and ordered, And likewise by fully  
resolved determined and ordered that the said Assembly be prorogued  
until the nine and twentieth day of October next ensuing  
being the last Sunday of the said month, And we do hereby  
will and require, as also strictly charge and command all and  
singular the Sheriffs of this Province, forthwith upon receipt
