 and punished as Divulgers of false news; And it is further declared
 that the Sheriff of each respective County in this Province do: cause the
 Proclamation to be read and published in the most publick convenient
 places within their precincts, and that all persons whatsoever do: take
 due cognizance thereof. /

 be and personally appear both of them before the Board, in ord.
