Ordered that Mr. Court Hill of St. Maries
County succeed Mr. Robert Jones late of Calvert County
dead in the place of Examinor or Deputy Surveyor Gen^l
of this Province, and that he execute that Office upon
such terms, and with such fees,quisites and profits
as were allowed and settled thereupon by his Test in the
conditions of plantation lately published within this
Province: Ordered also that all the books, papers
and writings late of the said Robert Jones (and now in
the custody of the Ex^{or} or Adm^r of the same) relating
to the said Place and Office of Examinor or Dep^y Surveyor
shall be forthwith delivered to the said Court Hill or
his ord^r and that all returns to be hereafter whome made
by the Deputy Surveyors of this Province as in such case
is accustomed and hath been done to the said Jones.
