The humble petition of James Ringold of Kent County. -

Humbly sheweth

That whereas your pet^r in the year 1683 brought his action
of debt against Michael Miller for thirty thousand pounds of debt
upon a bond of award, which said action proceeded to judgment
and on the fourth day of July in the year aforesaid at the
City of St. Maries, the said Michael Miller in the Gov^l Court
obtained a Non suit against your pet^r and the Court awarded
your pet^r to pay the s^d Michael two thousand eight hundred
twenty and three pounds of Tobacco, costs of Suit; And now
so it is may it please your Hon^{rs} your pet^r being much
grieved and damaged by means of the Non suit aforesaid
and for that the judgment process and proceedings aforesaid
of the said Michael Miller is erroneous and contrary to Law.

Your pet^r humbly prays his High writ of Error which
may be granted, and directed to the Justices of the
Gov^l Court, requiring them to send to his said High
in the upper house of the next Gen^l Assembly, the
Transfer of the Record process proceedings and Judgment
aforesaid, that inspection being therein had, his said
High in the said upper house of Assembly may cause to
be done therein, what of right and according to the Law,
of this Province ought to be done; And likewise his
High writs of Scire facias, and sup^rsedas thereupon,
the your said pet^r giving security for the same, according
to the act of Assembly in that case made.

And your pet^r shall pray the

That writ of Error and Scire facias issue, and if
Execution be not served to the sup^rsedas aforesaid as is prayed
the pet^r giving good Security for the same.
