The humble petition of James Ridgolds of Kent County  
Humbly sheweth

That at a Provinciale Court held at the City of S<sup>t</sup>. Maries  
the fourth day of March Anno D<sup>ni</sup> 1684: One Michael Miller  
obtained judgment ag<sup>t</sup> your p<sup>t</sup> upon an action of Trespass upon the  
case to the damages of two and twenty thousand pounds of tobacco  
and costs of Suits, which s<sup>d</sup> judgment was obtained contrary to  
Law, and therefore is manifestly Erroneous (as may hereafter appear)  
to the great damage of your p<sup>t</sup>.

Your p<sup>t</sup> therefore humbly prays your Hon<sup>rs</sup> to award  
him the L<sup>tes</sup> writt of Error upon the judgment aforesaid  
to the Justices of the Provinciale Court to be directed,  
requiring them to send to the upper house of the next  
generall Assembly, the transcript of the Record proceedings  
proceedings and judgment aforesaid, that inspection being  
thereunto had, the said L<sup>tes</sup> in the said upper house of  
Assembly, w<sup>ch</sup> cause to be done therein, what of right  
and according to the Lawes of this Province, ought to be  
done, and likewise the L<sup>tes</sup> writt of Scire facias, and  
superioras thereupon, according to an Act of Assembly  
in that case made and provided. — Your L<sup>tes</sup> giving any  
security therefore —

And your L<sup>tes</sup> as in duty bound shall ever pray &c.

That writt of Error and Scire facias issue (if  
expulsion be not forced) but superioras also issue as  
is prayed, the p<sup>t</sup> giving good security for the same —
