M^{rs}: Ann Thompson the wife of Robert Thompson of Charles County being convicted by the Justices of the Province Court, and adjudged to be burnt in the hand for having two husbands, made her humble address to this board and prayed their hon^{rs} Commiseration of her condition humbly acknowledging her Error therein, and faithfully promising amendment of life and to be more wary and diligent for the future upon w^{ch} and upon condition of her promise wholly to desert and forsake the Company of him whom she last married, and cleave to her first former husband Mr. Robert Thompson only, with him soberly & honestly to live, It is considered that she be acquitted of the punishment due to her upon the judgment aforesaid as to the corporall punishment of burning in the hand, and ordered that pardon be drawn accordingly.
