or either of them that shall at any time hereafter commit any
breach of this Law, committed by any person or persons whatsoever, the
sum being first proved against such Magistrate or Magistrates,
for concealing the same; Such Magistrate or Magistrates shall be
fined for every such Offence the sum of One Thousand pounds
of Tobacco to be recovered by way of Execution upon him or their
goods or Chattels.

All which fines and forfeitures aforesaid to be recovered of
aforesaid shall be disposed of at the discretion of the Mayor
Kings and Aldermen for the use being

Item It is further enacted ordained & established by the Mayor Kings
Aldermen and Common Council in aforesaid that the Sheriff or
Sub Sheriff of St. Marys County shall and may execute all
writs and process within this City upon any person or persons
forfeiture or otherwise against whom such process shall issue;
The said Sheriff or Sub Sheriff first giving notice thereof to any
the Magistrate, or to the Clerk of this City that the same may
be entered, for which duty the said Clerk shall have and receive
of the City in such case the sum of two pounds sterling or
two pounds of Tobacco as he shall think fit

Item Be it also enacted, ordained and established that all fines
already levied, and hereafter to be levied for anything or matter
whatsoever, shall be put into the hands of the Mayor for the
King, or such Officer as shall be by the Court appointed for that
purpose, to be employed towards reparation of the Landing, or
to such other use as the Court shall think fit

Item It is also enacted thought fit, and established that all persons
that bring their servants to the Mayor's Court to be adjudged, shall pay
two pounds sterling for the first time, which is two
shillings and six pence sterling

Item It is also thought fit and convenient to be enacted, and Be it
enacted established and ordained, that all housekeepers within this
City do by the last day of November next ensuing provide to
their Chimneys two ladders, One twenty four feet, and the other
twelve feet in length, under the penalty of One hundred pounds
of Tobacco fine a piece upon default

Item It is also thought fit and convenient and enacted established
and ordained that all Chimneys in this City shall be by the last
day of November next last laid, damped and plastered under
the penalty of five hundred pounds of Tobacco fine, to be paid
